

**REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMON COUNCIL
CITY OF ELWOOD, MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA
COUNCIL CHAMBERS, MUNICIPAL BUILDING
FEBRUARY 6, 2012 7:00 PM**

Meeting called to order by Mayor Arnold followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer. Members present: Brent Boston, Kim Everson, Todd Jones, Matt Leeson, Brandon Melvin, Eric Reese, and Tim Roby. City Attorney, Jim Wilson, was present for the meeting.

Mayor Arnold asked for any public comment or concerns.

Minutes from the January 2, 2012 regular meeting and January 16, 2012 special meeting were presented to the council for approval. Leeson made a motion to approve the minutes as written; seconded by Reese. All in favor.

The outstanding checks of two years as of December 31st, 2011 were presented to the council by Allison Atwood, Clerk-Treasurer. Jones made a motion to approve the voiding of the outstanding check list; seconded by Leeson. All in favor.

Brady Dyer, Common Wealth, spoke concerning Ordinance 2130. This ordinance is for the waste water treatment process. It is setting regulations of what business and citizens can dispose into their waste water. Reese asked why the City of Elwood's limits are so high. Dyer explained the process of setting the limits with our different industries. Mike Washburn, waste water supervisor, said he did not see anything with the ordinance. Brady wants the ordinance to be tabled due to discussions with Red Gold. No action took place.

Mayor Arnold asked if there were any council committee reports. Award committee is currently holding nominations in the Clerk-Treasurers office for City Employee of the Quarter. Recycling committee has met and went over figures that were reported by the recycling department. Glen Murray, insurance committee has been working on different quotes per the Clerk-Treasurer.

Mayor Arnold stated that the 1782 notice has been received and we are working hard with Reedy Financing Group on changes. We did receive our maximum levy.

Jones made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Leeson. All in favor; meeting adjourned.
