Meeting called to order by Mayor Arnold. Members present: Merrill Taylor. Member absent: Albert McPhearson. City attorney, Jim Wilson, was present for the meeting.

Street Paving bids were opened as follows:

Midwest Paving, LLC	\$132,190.00	\$57,801.10


Street Commissioner, Jim Robertson recommended to the board approving E & B Paving as this was the lowest bid and if funding becomes available adding the 9th Street option. Taylor made a motion to approve E & B Paving for the project with the option of adding 9th Street; seconded by Arnold. All in favor.

Robertson also questioned the board on the sale of the old recycle truck. Robertson stated several people have expressed interest in purchasing this vehicle. Wilson stated a notice should be run in the paper to except bids.
