

**SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY
CITY OF ELWOOD, MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA
COUNCIL CHAMBERS, MUNICIPAL BUILDING
FEBRUARY 8, 2016 6:00PM**

Meeting called to order by Mayor Jones. Members present: Marc Crim, Kelli Boyland, Kim Everson, and Tim Roby. City attorney, Jeff Graham, was present for the meeting.

Police Chief, Jason Brizendine recommended William Maluvac be offered conditional employment with the city. Maluvac passed all city physical and written requirements. Crim made a motion to offer conditional employment pending PERF approval; seconded by Boyland. All in favor.

Brizendine also requested the board approve the purchase of a training monitor and accessories for the squad room in the amount of \$1299.96 from Best Buy. Brizendine stated this would allow necessary information to be accessed by officers but not visible to the public. Boyland made a motion to allow the purchase; seconded by Everson. All in favor.

The MOU regarding the county-wide E911 radio system was presented to the board for approval. This is updated to include the building of a 180 foot tower at a cost of \$30,000.00 by the city for the new system. Crim made a motion to accept the MOU; seconded by Roby. All in favor.


A breakdown of stone pricing for 2016 was presented to the board. Street Commissioner, David Jones explained the need for the stone. Everson made a motion to table the issue for further investigation; seconded by Boyland. All in favor.

Boyland stated that she and board member Crim visited the park house and the damage to the interior of the home is unacceptable. Boyland presented the board with pictures of the interior damage. Boyland stated she felt the park board was not doing justice to the city and its residents. Boyland recommended that the mayor disband the park board and assume all duties of the board. Crim stated he was in agreeance with Boyland. Jones stated he would take the suggestion under advisement.

Everson made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Boyland. All in favor; meeting adjourned.
