



**ORDINANCE NO. 2057 2<sup>nd</sup> AMENDMENT - AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING INCREMENT, LONGEVITY, HOLIDAY PAY, UNIFORM ALLOWANCE; AND OTHER MISCELLANEOUS COMPENSATION FOR FIREFIGHTERS AND POLICE OFFICERS DETERMINING SENIORITY RIGHTS WITH RESPECT TO POLICE OFFICERS AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.** Atwood stated this was to increase police clothing and adjust the longevity breakdown for police. Officer Copus spoke regarding the cost of uniforms and the affect the longevity change would have in the department. Jones made a motion to table Ordinance 2057 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment till the council could review the budget further; seconded by Leeson. All in favor.

**ORDINANCE NO. 2077 2<sup>nd</sup> AMENDMENT – PERSONNEL POLICY OF THE CITY OF ELWOOD, MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.** Atwood stated the election days have been removed and replace with Martin Luther King Jr. Day and Columbus Day thus keeping the number of holidays the same as last year. Savage stated the state does recognize these as state holidays. Jones questioned if these holidays could be passed in time for the utility to receive them. John Wright, union rep for the utility, stated he would amend the contract to be the same as the city policy and have passed at next Board of Works which would be in time to take the holiday. Jones made a motion to read and consider Ordinance 2077 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment; seconded by Boston. Ordinance 2077 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment read title only. Jones made a motion to vote on Ordinance 2077 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment roll call vote; seconded by Leeson. Roll call vote: Boston – aye, Everson – aye, Jones – aye, Leeson – aye, Reese – aye, Roby – aye, Savage – aye. Ordinance 2077 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment passed.

**ORDINANCE NO. 2162 2<sup>nd</sup> AMENDMENT – AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE BI-WEEKLY AND HOURLY COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF ELWOOD UTILITIES, MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA, AND EFFECTIVE DATES THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.** Atwood stated there was a line omitted during the previous passing and therefore, it needed to be passed again. Jones made a motion to read and consider Ordinance 2162 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment; seconded by Jones. All in favor. Ordinance 2162 as amended read title only. Jones made a motion to vote on Ordinance 2162 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment roll call vote; seconded by Leeson. Roll call vote: Boston – aye, Everson – aye, Jones – aye, Leeson – aye, Reese – aye, Roby – aye, Savage - aye. Ordinance 2162 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment passed.

Boston made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Leeson. All in favor; meeting adjourned.
