**ORDINANCE NO. 2235** – 2016 BUDGET. Clerk-Treasurer, Allison Atwood stated the State Board of Accounts recommended passing the 2016 budget regardless of prior issues. Jones made a motion to read and consider Ordinance 2235; seconded by Boston. All in favor. Ordinance 2235 read title only. Jones made a motion for unanimous consent for passage on the same night as introduced; seconded by Boston. All in favor. Jones made a motion to vote on Ordinance 2235 roll call vote; seconded by Boston. Roll call vote: Boston – aye, Everson – aye, Jones – aye, Rice – aye, Roby – aye. Ordinance 2235 passed.

Jones inquired about placing a stop sign at South A and South 12<sup>th</sup> Streets. Police Chief, Phil Caldwell stated his recommendation would be South 11<sup>th</sup> Street and that it definitely needs one.

Police Chief, Phil Caldwell gave a report on the statistics of having a school resource officer.


